

## Admission Regulations and Procedures for New Students

All first-year candidates are required to submit an application for admission along with the required material. Studentsmay submit an application through the online portal or a paper-bad pnle-8 (a)]TJ 0 Tc 0





Applicants whose application has been rejected may appeal at the ASPC committee for allowation. More information on how to file an appeal or a complaint can be found in the committee for a section B, Paragraph 5.

Applications receive a priority number which determines the order in which successful applicants registerfor their first semesterof coursework.

## **TransferStudents**


ACTwelcomesapplications from transferstudents who complete the following criteria:

- 1. Englishlanguageproficiencyasdescribedabove.
- 2. Previousacademicwork is completed at a regionally accredited institution.
- 3. Coursesapplytowardsthe ACT curriculum.
- 4. Courseshavebeencompleted with a minimum grade of "C" or its equivalent.

## Notes:

- 1. ACT considers transfer claims for up to the two thirds of credits required for a full undergraduate bachelor's degree.
- 2. ACT will not transfer credit for courses that are classified as Level 6 in the Open University programmes.
